NKT has signed the order for offshore export power cables

for the Baltic Pow-er Offshore Wind Park, which will be the first offshore wind farm in Poland. located 23 km off the coast. With 76 wind turbines, it provides a capacity of up to 1.2 GW and will thereby be an important contributor to the Polish ambitions to install up to 11 GW of offshore wind in the Baltic Sea by 2040. Prysmian is TSO's Preferred Bidder for Offshore Grid Cable Project in Germany

Prysmian Group, leading energy/telecom cable systems,

Prysmian was selected by Group the TSO Amprion, one of the leading European TSOs, as preferred bidder for the two Offshore Grid Connection Systems BalWin1 and BalWin2 and the underground cable project DC34. The preferred bidder agreement provides an obligation on the parties to negotiate in good faith the outstanding items of the projects with a target to execute the final contracts by January 15, 2024. Prysmian is committed to reserve the required production and installation capacity until that date. The contracts are valued in aggregate at around €4.5 billion. The projects are part of Germany's plan to install 70 GW of offshore wind energy by 2045 and support transmission of energy generated in the North Sea to consumers in the western and southern parts of the country.

"This agreement is a huge step towards realizing these three important projects in time. So the major components for our offshore projects are secured until 2030," said **Hendrik Neumann**, CTO of Amprion.



Hellenic Cables Wins Supply Contracts

Hellenic Cables, the cables segment of Cenergy Holdings, recently signed a contract with DEME Offshore, a leading

offshore energy contractor for the supply of inter-array cables for the Eoliennes en mer Dieppe Le Tréport (EMDT), an offshore wind farm in France, located off the coast in the English Channel, which is expected to be commissioned in 2026. The EMDT OWF is a joint venture between **Ocean Winds, Sumitomo Corporation** and **la Bangue des Territoires**.

Hellenic Cables was also awarded a contract by **50Hertz Offshore GmbH** for the turnkey delivery of two export cable systems for the interconnection to the German grid of the Western Offshore Sub Station of Gennaker, an offshore wind farm with a capacity of some 927 MW located in the German Baltic Sea, utilizing 220kV AC technology.

The Gennaker wind farm will be one of the most powerful offshore wind farms in the Baltic Sea to date and thus, it will make an important contribution to the German government's ambitious plans and targets for accelerating the energy transition.
