Hellenic Cables Awarded XLPE Cables Contract for Offshore Wind Farms

Hellenic Cables, the cables segment of **Cenergy Holdings**, has **HELLENIC CABLES**

been awarded by the Swedish power company, **Vattenfall**, the design, manufacture, testing and supply of some 70 km 66 kV XLPE insulated inter-array cables and associated accessories for Vesterhav Nord/Syd offshore wind farm project.

The Vesterhav project consists of two wind farms Vesterhav Nord and Vesterhav Syd, with a total capacity of 350 MW. Both will produce climate-friendly electricity, equivalent to the annual consumption of 380,000 Danish households. The two wind farms will increase the Danish electricity generation from wind energy, making a significant contribution to the country's green transition. The cables will be made at Hellenic's vertically integrated submarine cable production site in Corinth, Greece. JDR to supply Vineyard Wind
